National Education Policy NEP 2020, after 34 years was released on 29th July 2020 which had brought a tremendous change in Educational field, its structure related to curriculum frame work based upon foundational pillars such as access, quality, equity, affordability, and accountability with different disciplines in schools such as improving the quality of Education given to secondary school children, curriculum and pedagogical aspects are re-oriented to attain critical

2. REVIEW OF RELATED LITERATURE

Aithal, Shubhrajyotsna Aithal (2020), This study has aimed to know about the various policies present earlier in the higher education system the lacking of teachers to teach various subjects in schools with less number of students in the classrooms ,dropping out of the students from schools in different villages due to unavailability of the teachers comparing with the present policy of the education and the study lacks behind the multiple entry and exist system of education, 21st century skills in schools, multi-disciplinary approach of education in higher education system.

Renu Gandhi (2021), The study has reviewed on the key features of NEP 2020 towards pre-school education categorized the pre-school education system as pre-nursery schools, Anganwadi centres, experimental pre-schools, nurseries attached to big recognized schools, nursery classes run by municipal corporation of Delhi, giving importance of experiential learning as sports and arts integrated education, showing the importance of language, developing the basic skills educating the importance of the personal hygienic skill conditions among the students at preschool age children. This study lacks behind the facilities and curriculum provided to the pre-school children in the educational system, improving 21st century skills provided to schools.

Mohsin Ali Khan (2022), The study have published an article related to NEP 2020 as refreshing our education system through NEP 2020 predictions and challenges saying that NEP 2020 has enormous change in the education system such as equity, equality, access, affordability, and accountability with actual originality of education system and its out comes by spending 6 % of GDP on education system with enhancement of 21st century skills in learning along with vocational skills for the students which also equalize inclusive equitable education and core teaching skills for teachers to enhance their teaching skills in their teaching profession.

Dr. Imran Ansari, Dr. Ali Haider,(2023) They conducted a survey on teacher educators perception about implementation of NEP 2020 in teacher training institute, they have collected data through survey method in different states of our country and analyzed with closed and open ended questions with items related to newly proposed pedagogical structure, 5+3+3+4 positively effect on teachers, multiple entry and exist point system with most effective implementation of NEP 2020 with analyzing factors that most of the teacher educators play a key role and are aware of recent developments occurred to facilitate implementation of NEP 2020 with proper finance infrastructure multiple disciplinary subjects with multiple analysis along with financial funding for stand-alone colleges and universities with good infrastructure facilities which can make a good environment for a proper teaching – learning process. The study lacks behind improper infrastructure with multiple disciplinary subjects and proposed pedagogical structure with 5+3+3+4 in schools and colleges with multiple entry and exist point system for implementation of NEP 2020.

Dr. Pandhare Vidyulata .D (2023), This study had a research related to NEP 2020 concerning to school complex regarding that the school complex should be according to the children and their requirements by which the students enroll themselves in the school by observing the environment, providing the school subjects accordingly and subject teacher with the most important and basic facilities for all the students present in the school with an effective management and administration process even by providing with all the infrastructure water facility , toilet facility library, laboratory and many more facilities regarding to the school for all the students to grow and develop as the complete holistic development. The study lacks behind the 21st century skills, multiple approach of learning, experienced based learning, activity based learning etc.

Mayuri Boruah, Puja Borkakaty(2023), The study have undergone a research related to the article of online resources for the training, teaching -learning process in NEP 2020 which emphasized upon the online resources enhancing the students knowledge, understanding skills, which highlights the e-learning process, creating digital infrastructure, promoting of appropriate online teaching learning platforms, creating digital depositors, focusing telecast and broadcast emphasizing on all Indian languages, creating virtual labs which creates easy and equal access for all students which makes students to access with hands on experience, experiment based learning teachers need rigorous training to handle and create high quality of online platforms, promoting blended mode of learning for different subjects, using online platforms for examination purpose for all the students and teachers and can study in a broad perspective with a holistic development, effective teaching models, teaching learning process, technical skills etc. by the importance of online resources.

This lacks behind curriculum which related to the student in their different subjects left behind as well as vocational studies for students who learns various skills and importance of 21^{st} century skills make every student to handle every problematic situation every easily and can solve the problem accordingly which is lacking behind in educational system.

Pawan Kalyani,(2020), The study has explored in in studying about the awareness of NEP 2020 by providing questionnaire survey to the parents, stake holders, teachers, students, etc, and the effect on the stakeholders begins with the Gurukul system of education 10+2 which has been replaced by 5+3+3+4 system of education by which every student has their own ideas for selecting their own subjects. The study has analyzed various responses from respondents through social media platform either directly / indirectly associated with NEP 2020. The study has analyzed that most of the persons responses from the questionnaire related to NEP 2020. Maximum respondents of 55% people had supported to NEP 2020 which may provide various subjects with multiple entry and exist system of education, it creates business opportunities, demand for training institutes, provide employment opportunities with a perfect platform for the use of technology with proper planning and administration with an assessment of improvement in teaching and learning process will yield a good result with positive impact in the society and benefit for all the generation in the society.

There is a lack in emphasizing universalization of education and implementation of NEP 2020 will be possible with a proper implementation in various schools with effective provisions and a proper feed back from the stake holders, administrators, organizers, teachers, students, parents, society, community etc.

Vijay Anant Athavale, Rajni Bansal, (2021), The Study has emphasized upon the distinctive notable reforms which is concerned with NEP 2020 along with key challenges and distinctive features of NEP 2020 which have made a new change

in the education system and pattern of curriculum structure from 10+2+3 replaced with 5+3+3+4 curriculum structure, effective implementation of teaching learning process in schools, flexibility to choose with different subjects multiple entry and exist system with respect to education pattern other pedagogical problems in respective schools, grading pattern, evaluation process for the students, policy implementation regarding 6% GDP is a challenging task and a support from the state and central education councils with respect to funds for effective implementation.

4. CONCLUSIONS

- Emphasizing upon the technical education, distance education, online education with the enhancement of the educational program which prefers nationality.
